

The specs show the base being 8' - 13' but then the specs call for 5" in from the edges of the pedestal. The dimensions add up to 125" so the pedestal base would be 135" based on these drawings. Are the signs going to all scale to keep the same 5" from each side and scale the base proportionately?	For 8' to 10' signs bases shall be 3". We will review and finalize after review of shop drawings.





Have you coordinated with FDOT & County to obtain approval for the placement of your signs in their ROW to know they are allowed? 2. Will you provide addresses or parcel IDs for each location that can be used for permitting? 3. Will you provide site plans or surveys suitable for determining setbacks and sign locations for approvals and permitting? 4. Please confirm the location #3 sign will be on the roadside, not in the center median. Should it be single-faced? 5. Do you want us to remove and discard existing palms/shrubs at the sign locations, or will The City move them to another location before we install the signs? 6. What “Landscaping” is required for each location after the sign is installed? Please provide applicable Maintenance Agreements and/or Beautification Agreements? 7. Is this a Davis Bacon project? If so, what are the prevailing wages to be used? 8. What is the required warranty on the signs? 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. For the Rock Island Road and NW 64th Ave. locations, the owner and jurisdiction is the City of North Lauderdale. For the SR 7 locations, the owner and jurisdiction is the FDOT. For the McNab Road location, the owner and jurisdiction is Broward County. All agencies have preliminarily approved the installation of the welcome signs, pending permit application and approval by the selected contractor. 2. <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. Sign #1 is located in the City medium ROW of Rock Island Road (No ID#) b. Sign #2 is located in the City medium ROW of NW 64th Ave (Folio #494110010017). c. Sign #3 is located in County side of ROW off NW 62nd St (Folio #494207010210). d. Sign #4 is located in FDOT medium ROW of State Road 7 (Folio 49413010190). e. Sign #5 is located in FDOT medium ROW of State Road 7 (No ID#). 3. To be provided by the City to selected Contractor. 4. Location to be side of road in ROW. Sign to be double-faced. 5. Tree removal to be carried by GC. All tree/shrubs landscaping by the City. 6. Landscaping shall be kept to re-sodding around new work scope area with similar sod. 7. No. 8. 5-year warranty on workmanship and materials.

All other documents, specifications, drawings, terms and conditions remain the same.
