



REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS

ALL PROSPECTIVE PROPOSERS:

The City is requesting sealed proposals for **FIRE STATIONS 34 & 44 WIND RETROFIT** for the City of North Lauderdale. Sealed proposals, including one (1) original, three (3) copies, and one (1) single pdf file on a flash drive, addressed to the City Clerk of the City of North Lauderdale, Florida, and will be accepted by the Office of the City Clerk, 701 SW 71st Avenue, North Lauderdale, Florida 33068 until 2:00 pm EST, **Tuesday, January 7, 2019** for:

FIRE STATIONS 34 & 44 WIND RETROFIT RFP #19-11-386

SCOPE OF WORK: The project is to retrofit the buildings with high velocity hurricane zone (HVHZ) large-missile impact garage doors at fire stations 34 & 44; install new impact rated windows, doors and new roof on fire station 44. The project shall provide protections against a 170 MPH winds or the wind speed protection and impact requirements indicated by the effective Florida Building Code at the time permits are issued. Wind protections shall be provided on any other opening such as vents, louvers and exhaust fans. All installations shall be completed in strict compliance with Federal, State and Local applicable Rules and Regulations. The local municipal or county building department will inspect and certify installation according to the manufacture specifications.

A **mandatory pre-proposal/site-visit meeting** will be held on **Tuesday, December 17, 2019 @ 9:00am EST**. Interested Consultants are to meet at Fire Station 34 Conference Room located at **6151 Bailey Road, North Lauderdale, FL 33068**.
