### ALL PROSPECTIVE BIDDERS:

The City is requesting sealed bids for **MEDIAN ENTRY WELCOME SIGNAGE** for the City of North Lauderdale. Sealed bids, including one (1) original, three (3) copies, and one (1) single pdf file on a flash drive, addressed to the Purchasing Division of the City of North Lauderdale, Broward County, Florida, and will be accepted by the Office of the City Clerk, 701 SW 71<sup>st</sup> Avenue, North Lauderdale, Florida 33068 until 10:00 am EST, **Thursday, September 10, 2020**, for:

**SCOPE OF WORK:** The City of North Lauderdale is seeking bids for five monument structures to be designed and constructed in accordance with the architectural drawings, pictures, and design requirements included herein **Attachment A through Attachment C of Exhibit A**. The locations where the City of North Lauderdale is planning to install the median entry welcome signage are (1) Rock Island by SW 3<sup>rd</sup> Court. Approximately 8'-0" long. (2) 64<sup>th</sup> Avenue near SW 24<sup>th</sup> Street. Approximately 10'-0" long. (3) McNab Road (NW 62<sup>nd</sup> Street). Approximately 13'-0" long. (4) State Road 7 near Prospect Rd. Approximately 10'-0" long. (5) State Road 7 north of Kimberly Boulevard. Approximately 8'-0" long.
