The City is requesting sealed bids for **REMOTE STRUCTURE CONCRETE INSTALLATION FOR MCNAB ROAD** for the City of North Lauderdale. SCOPE OF WORK: This specification covers the installation of a concrete apron structure along the City's barrier wall adjacent to McNab Road. The sections are from Rock Island Road east to 68th Avenue and continuing east from 68th Avenue to the State Road 7 overpass. The contractor will be responsible for excavating and disposing of the existing soil and vegetation, grading, compacting, installation of approximately 5280 linear feet of 3000 psi concrete and Maintenance of Traffic for the worksite.
