AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF NORTH LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, AMENDING SUBPART B ENTITLED "LAND DEVELOPMENT CODE/REGULATIONS," ARTICLE V, ENTITLED "COMMUNITY SUSTAINABILITY BOARD," SECTION 78-114, ENTITLED "PUBLIC ART PROGRAM;" PROVIDING DEFINITIONS; PROVIDING FOR A PUBLIC ART FEE; PROVIDING FOR A PUBLIC ART FUND; PROVIDING FOR REQUIREMENTS OF THE PUBLIC ART PROGRAM; PROVIDING FOR THE RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE COMMUNITY SUSTAINABILITY BOARD; PROVIDING FOR ARTIST AND ART SELECTION CRITERIA; PROVIDING FOR OWNERSHIP OF ARTWORK; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF NORTH LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, AMENDING CHAPTER 66, ENTITLED "TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES", SECTION 66-41, ENTITLED "ADMINISTRATIVE APPEALS", PROVIDING FOR ADMINISTRATIVE APPEAL OF TOWING CHARGES; AMENDING CHAPTER 106, ENTITLED "ZONING", ARTICLE V, ENTITLED "GENERAL SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS", SECTION 106-203, ENTITLED "PARKING IN SWALE AREA", PROVIDING FOR DESIGNATION OF NO-PARKING ZONE SOUTH OF MORROW ELEMENTARY, ADJACENT TO SW 5TH STREET/FOREST BOULEVARD, NO-PARKING SIGNS, AND PARKING IN CITY PARKS; AMENDING CHAPTER 106, ENTITLED "ZONING", ARTICLE VI, ENTITLED "OFF-STREET PARKING AND LOADING AND PARKING RESTRICTIONS", SECTION 106-235, ENTITLED "VIOLATIONS OF ANY PARKING RESTRICTIONS", PROVIDING FOR TOWING AND IMPOUNDMENT; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

ALL AFFECTED PERSONS WILL BE ALLOWED TO PRESENT EVIDENCE AT THE HEARING, BRING FORTH WITNESSES AND CROSS-EXAMINE WITNESSES PROVIDED THEY NOTIFY AND FILE THE REQUIRED FORMS PROVIDED BY THE CITY CLERK'S OFFICE, AT LEAST SEVEN CALENDAR DAYS PRIOR TO THE PROCEEDING.
