James Williams, Purchasing Manager, opened the Pre-Bid Non-Mandatory meeting for ITB #20-07-401 Rock Island Intersection Improvements at 10:01 am EST on Monday, July 27, 2020. Mr. Williams advised that the purpose of the Pre-Bid meeting was to allow vendors to ask questions pertaining to ITB 20-07-401. He explained the process involved and that all of the vendors should have bid documents concerning this solicitation which include bid specifications, general constructions plans, Exhibit B General Forms and electronic pricing. He noted that there is a qualification statement which all vendors are requested to complete under General Forms. The City has local vendor preference for Broward County and if at the issuance of this Bid a vendor maintains a residence in Broward County or in the City of North Lauderdale then they are given an evaluation percentage credit. The deadline to submit additional questions is July 30, 2020, 2:00 p.m. In addition to the general questions all Bid proposals for ITB# 20-07-401 need to be submitted by August 19, 2020, 2:00 p.m. Sam May, Public Works Director briefly reviewed the scope of work for ITB 20-07-401. He introduced Freddy Vargas, the design engineer on the job and the contractor that will be handling the post construction. Mr. Williams opened the meeting for any questions.

Questions/ Answers:

- Q. Is there a proposed budget or engineer estimate on this project?
A. At this time there is no proposed budget for this particular project.
- Q. How about calendar dates?
A. The calendar dates are submitted into the ITB as listed.
- Q. Are work days 270?
A. Yes, the correct number of work days are 270.
