# In-Person Voting Health Protection & Recommendations

### **WE WILL:**

- ✓ Provide clean voting locations and temperature tested, masked poll workers;
- ✓ Provide hand sanitizer to all voters entering the polling location and courtesy masks if needed;
- ✓ Provide contact-free voter check-in and plastic-encased pens that may be taken with you after voting;
- ✓ Provide speedy access to your ballot and sufficient, distanced voting privacy booths to reduce time within the polling location; and
- ✓ Ensure privacy booths are located to facilitate social distancing and cleaned throughout the day.

### **WHAT THE VOTER SHOULD DO:**

- ✓ Before arriving to vote, confirm your address and other voting information. Call (954) 357-7050 or visit [www.browardsoe.org](http://www.browardsoe.org);
- ✓ Before arriving, study a sample ballot. You may bring a sample ballot with you to help cast your ballot quickly;
- ✓ Avoid touching your mouth or face inside the polling location to help maintain sanitation during the voting process;
- ✓ Limit discussion inside the polling location to help protect your fellow voters and poll workers; and
- ✓ Be mindful that Broward County has an ordinance requiring a face covering in all public places. You should bring a mask to vote; however, masks are available upon request at each polling location.
